Dear Speaker Pelosi:

We thank you for your decisive leadership to advance the Build Back Better Act. This is a oncein-a-generation opportunity to invest in our country, improve the health of Americans, meet the needs of working families, and rebuild from the devastation caused by the pandemic. As you prepare the Build Back Better Act and reaffirm the Majority's commitment to protecting Americans' health and fitness, we write to urge you to prioritize the inclusion of H.R. 890, the Gym Mitigation and Survival Act (GYMS Act).

In March 2020, almost all of the nation's more than 40,000 fitness facilities were ordered to shut down to stop the spread of COVID-19. When finally allowed to operate, fitness facilities were only able to do so under severe restrictions, the effects of which negatively impacted already depleted membership rates and revenue. The spread of the delta variant of COVID-19 has led to a return of restrictions on fitness facilities. This has devastated a sector which safeguards Americans' health: nearly 1 in 4 facilities has closed permanently, \$29.2 billion in revenue has been lost, and 47 percent of employees in the sector - 1.5 million - have lost their jobs.<sup>1</sup> Without direct, industry-specific aid, the effects will be long-lasting: 64 percent of small facility owners and operators report that they have taken on additional debt to stay in business due to the closures and restrictions, and 80 percent are still struggling with the long-term financial impact.<sup>2</sup>

The GYMS Act can reverse this distressing course. The GYMS Act would establish a grant program to provide economic support to distressed fitness facilities at risk of failure due to the

COVID-19 pandemic. It would allow for owners and operators to apply for grants from the Small Business Administration (SBA) and use the funds for payroll, rent, mortgage, utilities, insurance, and other expenses fitness facilities normally incur. Congress has successfully enacted similar measures to support the two other industries directly impacted by Covid-19 restrictions, restaurants and live venues. The GYMS Act is broadly popular and enjoys the support of nearly 60 percent of the Caucus.

The GYMS Act would save millions of jobs and tens of thousands of small businesses, would allow for Americans to take charge of their health and fitness, and would further fulfill our promise to Build Back Better. It is critical that we act on this legislation and make a direct investment in the health and fitness of all Americans. We urge you to prioritize the GYMS Act's inclusion in the Build Back Better Act.
